COURSE DESCRIPTION

This introductory level BBI course on Biblical and yet practical approach to Evangelism is rooted in our Lord's Great Commission and Gospel message. Our course will seek to introduce, aid and expand the student's understanding, skills and practice of Christian Evangelism at both the personal and corporate church community levels.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of this unit, the student will:

- A. *Be able to articulate a theology of Evangelism that is biblically based and informed by recent discussion of Mission Philosophy and Strategies.*
- B. *Be able to describe some major developments in the history of evangelism from the Brethren Perspectives and others. They will know and have a grasp of one contemporary area of evangelism where the church's witness is taking shape in a new and challenging manner.*
- C. *Be able to discuss ways in which the church's evangelism is both personal and social and how this is related to the Gospel.*
- D. *Be able to assess the extent of whether his or her congregation is an inviting community and to find desired next steps in view of that assessment. Discovering ways of evangelism from church perspective.*
- E. To indicate ways that faith sharing occurs in his or her life and practice a style of evangelism that works for their witness style.
